 - <http://picasa.google.com/> Limited photo editing but does have basics and provides way of keeping track of all photo's in your computer

- <http://www.picnik.com/app#/home/welcome> Simple, easy to use. Bought by Google but remains stand alone.

- <http://mozbackup.jasnapaka.com/> Back up Firefox and Thunderbird. Can transfer to new computer
